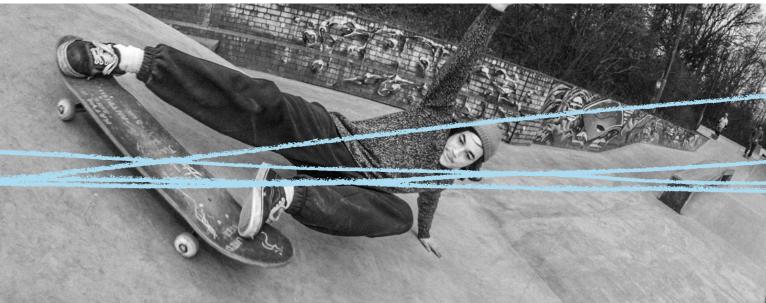
Given the dramatic rise in wheeled sports popularity, it's not surprising that the majority of campaigns to build new skateparks start with the riders themselves.

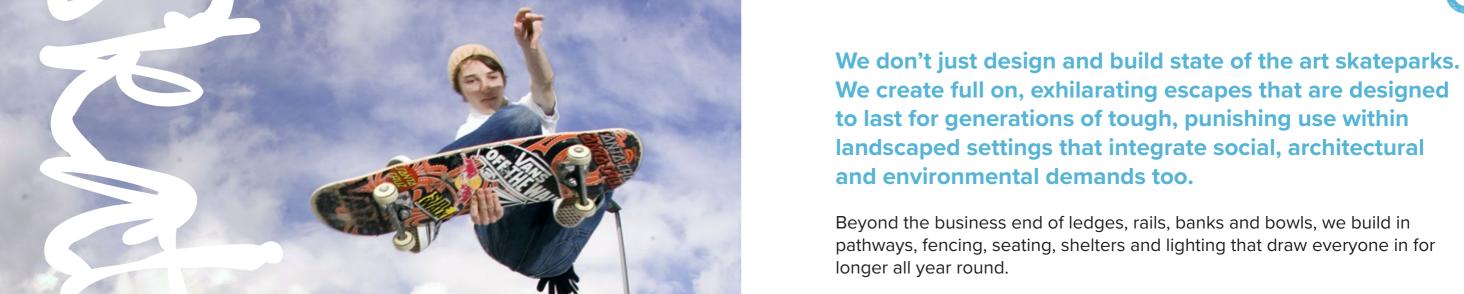
